Aims:-

The overall aim of this policy is to promote each child's right to express their gender and personality in whichever way feels right for them. To support this aim, our uniform policy is gender neutral. This means that whilst we expect all of our children to wear school uniform, the rules for boys and girls are the same, and we do not insist that they wear specific items of clothing.

Skirt	Grey or black	
Trousers	Grey or black	
School dress	Red check	
Pinafore	Grey	
Polo shirt	Red or white	
Sweatshirt	Red	
Cardigan	Red	
Leggings	Grey or black	Worn under skirt or pinafore only.
Hijab	Grey or black or white	Plain fabric only, not patterned or sequined.
PE shorts	Black	
PE top	White	
PE Pumps	Black	
Tights/socks	Grey, black or white	
Shoes	Black	Black trainers are acceptable without colour flashes or visible logos.
Hair	Plain accessories only	Hair that is longer than shoulder length should be tied back, no shaved patterns or added colours.
Jewellery	Small stud earrings only, wristwatch	This is for health & safety reasons. Children must be able to remove these themselves, and will be asked to do so for PE lessons.

Items with school logo are available at Clive Marks in Kings Heath, but it is much cheaper to buy plain items which are perfectly acceptable.

Please ensure that **ALL items of clothing and uniform are clearly labelled** with your child's name, as these are easier to identify, and we cannot be responsible for items that go missing.
